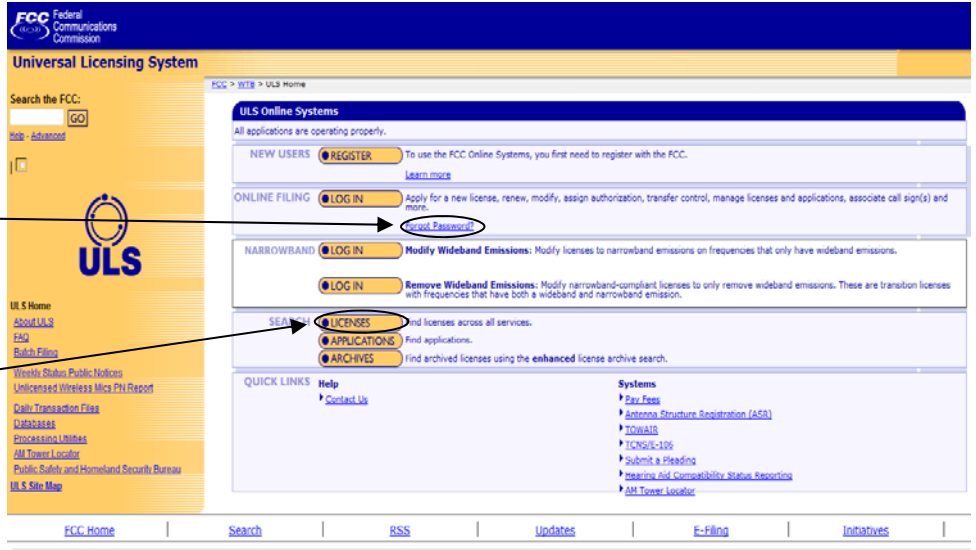


HOW TO GET A ULS PASSWORD

(IF YOU ALREADY HAVE AN FRN NUMBER)

This is only required if you want to, update your info, print a copy of your Official license, and renew your license.

Go to: <http://wireless.fcc.gov/uls/index.htm?job=home>



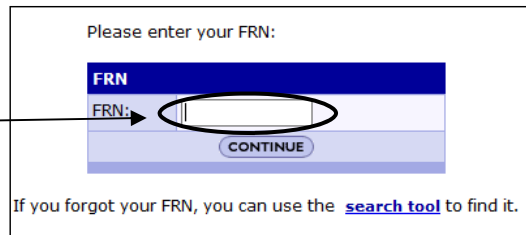
Click on **“Forgot Password?”**

Note:

You can access your file here and print a Reference Copy of your license but can't make any changes or print an Official Copy.

Next screen: **insert your FRN number.**

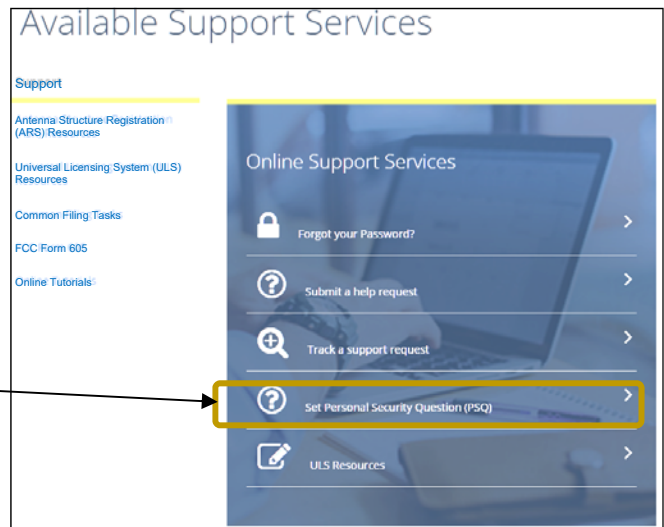
Your FRN is on the front of your Ham license. (include beginning zeros)



Your password for FRN 0001234567 cannot be reset because it does not have a Personal Security Question (PSQ) on file.

To continue please **request a PSQ.**

Next screen: **Click on “request a PSQ”**



Next screen: **Select “Set Personal Security Question (PSQ)”.**

Note:

You need an email address, or access to one, for the next form, otherwise I would suggest you select “Submit a help request”.

Leave "Entity is" to "-None-" if this FRN is yours.
